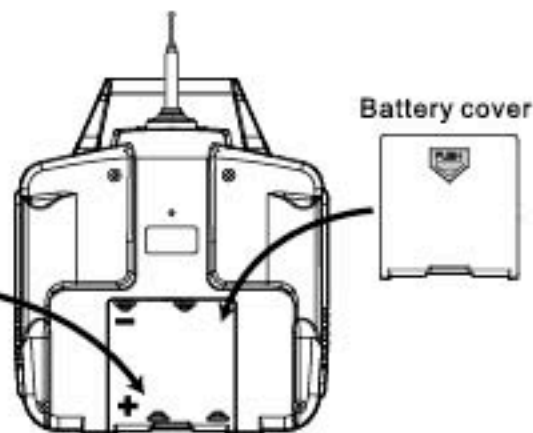
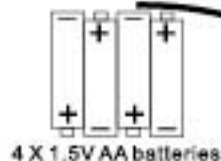
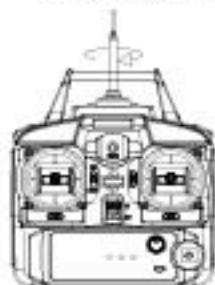

Battery Installation \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) Remove cover using a Phillips head screw driver.
  - 2) Insert 4 AA Alkaline Batteries into the tray provided.
- NOTE: Make sure the battery polarity is correct.**



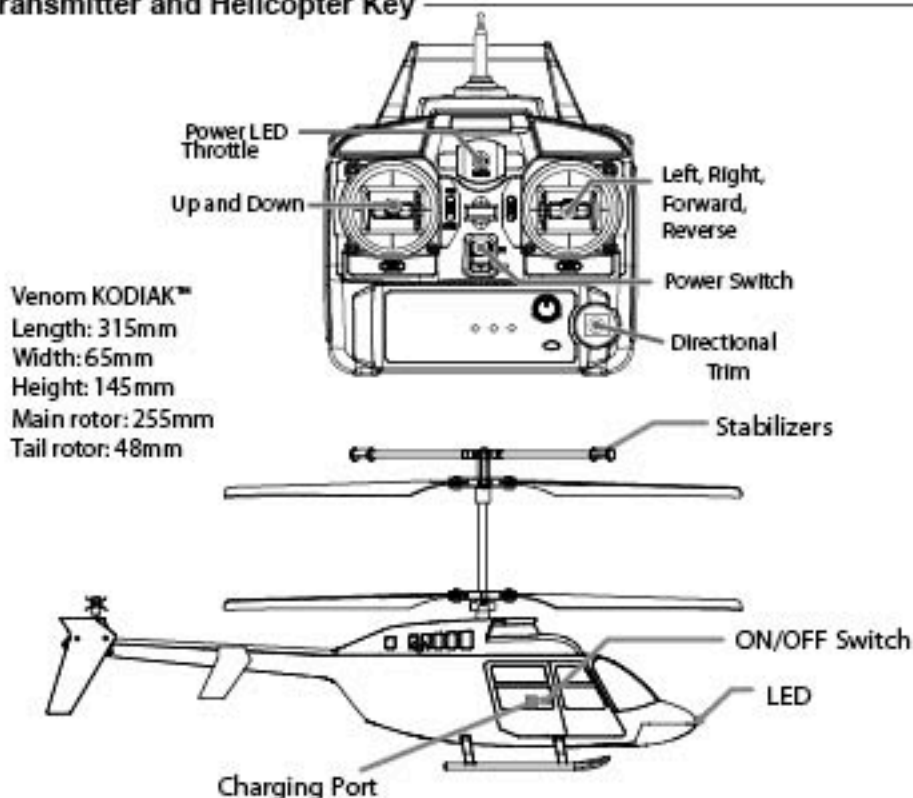


1. Plug the charger into an open wall outlet.
2. Make sure the helicopter ON/OFF switch is in the "OFF" position then insert the charging plug into the charging port on the bottom of the helicopter. When the light on the charger is RED this means the helicopter needs to be charged. When the light changes to green, the helicopter has been fully charged. The Venom KODIAK™ is now ready to fly.

**NOTE:** Charge times will vary depending on the amount of charge still left on the battery from previous flights. A fully discharged battery should take approximately 20-30 minutes to fully charge.

When the helicopter will no longer maintain a hover or gain altitude, the battery needs to be recharged. **DO NOT CONTINUE TO FLY THE HELICOPTER AS THIS MAY DAMAGE THE BATTERY!**

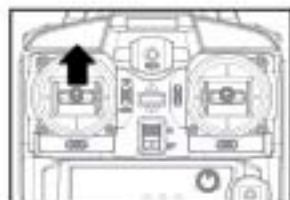

## Flying Instructions

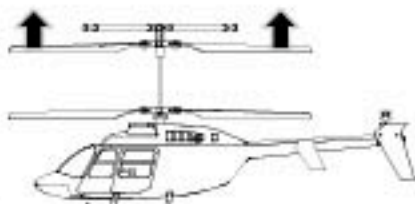


**CAUTION:** Before Turning the helicopter ON, turn the transmitter ON and place the throttle at 100% full and then place immediately to the 0% position. After this has been done, you may turn the helicopter on for flight.

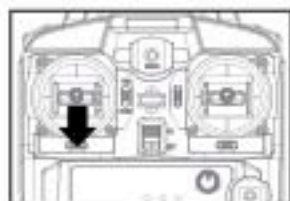


**UP**

To get the Venom™ KODIAK up, move the left control stick to the up position. Make sure to bring the control stick back down when the desired height is reached

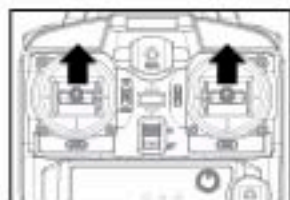
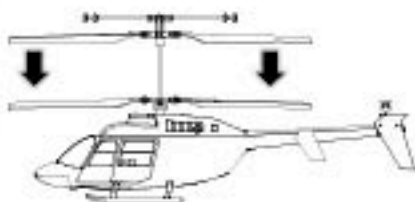


**NOTE: MAKE SURE THE HELICOPTER IS ON THE CORRECT CHANNEL**



**DOWN**

To lower your helicopter back down to the floor, slowly move the left control stick down. The slower the input the less chance you have of crashing the helicopter.



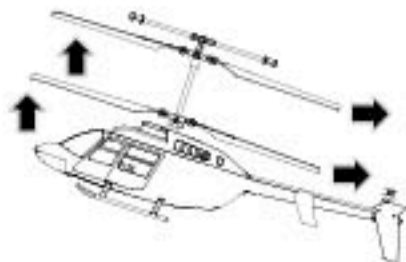
**FORWARD**

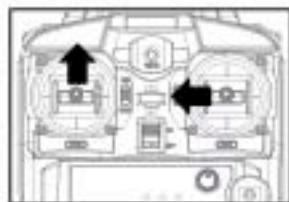
To move your helicopter forward, move the right control stick up with the left control stick up or at the desired throttle level.



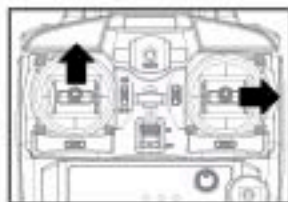
**REVERSE**

To move your helicopter in reverse, move the right control stick down with the left control stick up or at the desired throttle level.

(NOTE: BIRDS EYE VIEW)

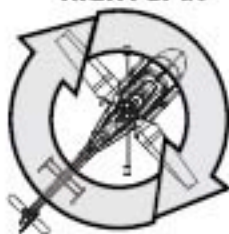


**RIGHT TURN**

## Adjusting the Left & Right Trim

### RIGHT SPIN



If your helicopter rotates to the **RIGHT** without any sort of input from the transmitter, turn the **DIRECTIONAL TRIM** to the **LEFT** to stop the helicopter from spinning to the right.

### LEFT SPIN



If your helicopter rotates to the **LEFT** without any sort of input from the transmitter, turn the **DIRECTIONAL TRIM** to the **RIGHT** to stop the helicopter from spinning to the left.

- When Flying the helicopter indoors, make sure you have a clear area of 20ft (Wide) x 30ft (Length) x 10ft (Height).

- When flying the helicopter outside, make sure the conditions are calm.
